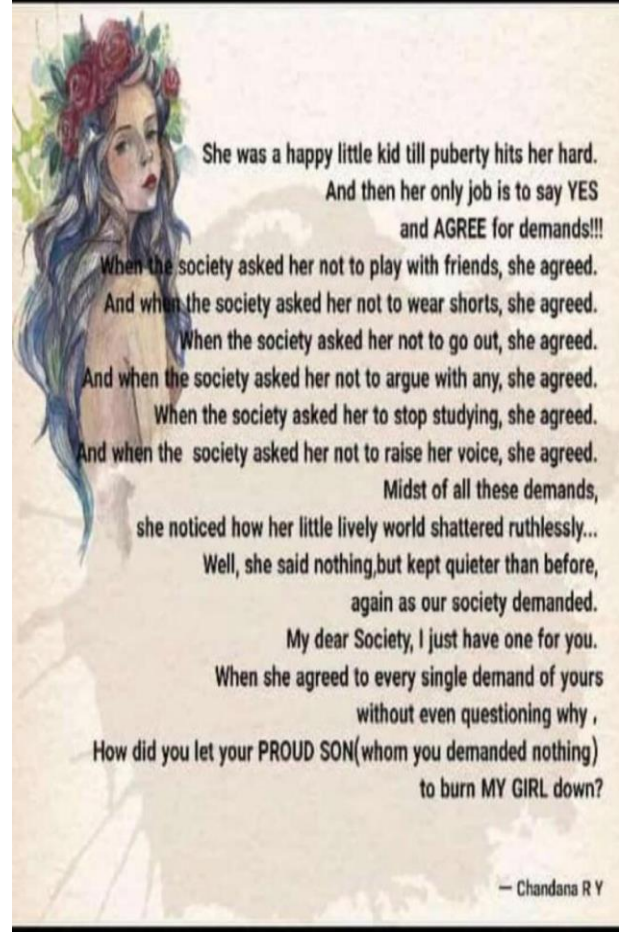
And also after every semester results, HOD use to personally congratulate class topper to keep the same momentum and use to motivate us to bring a Rank to department.

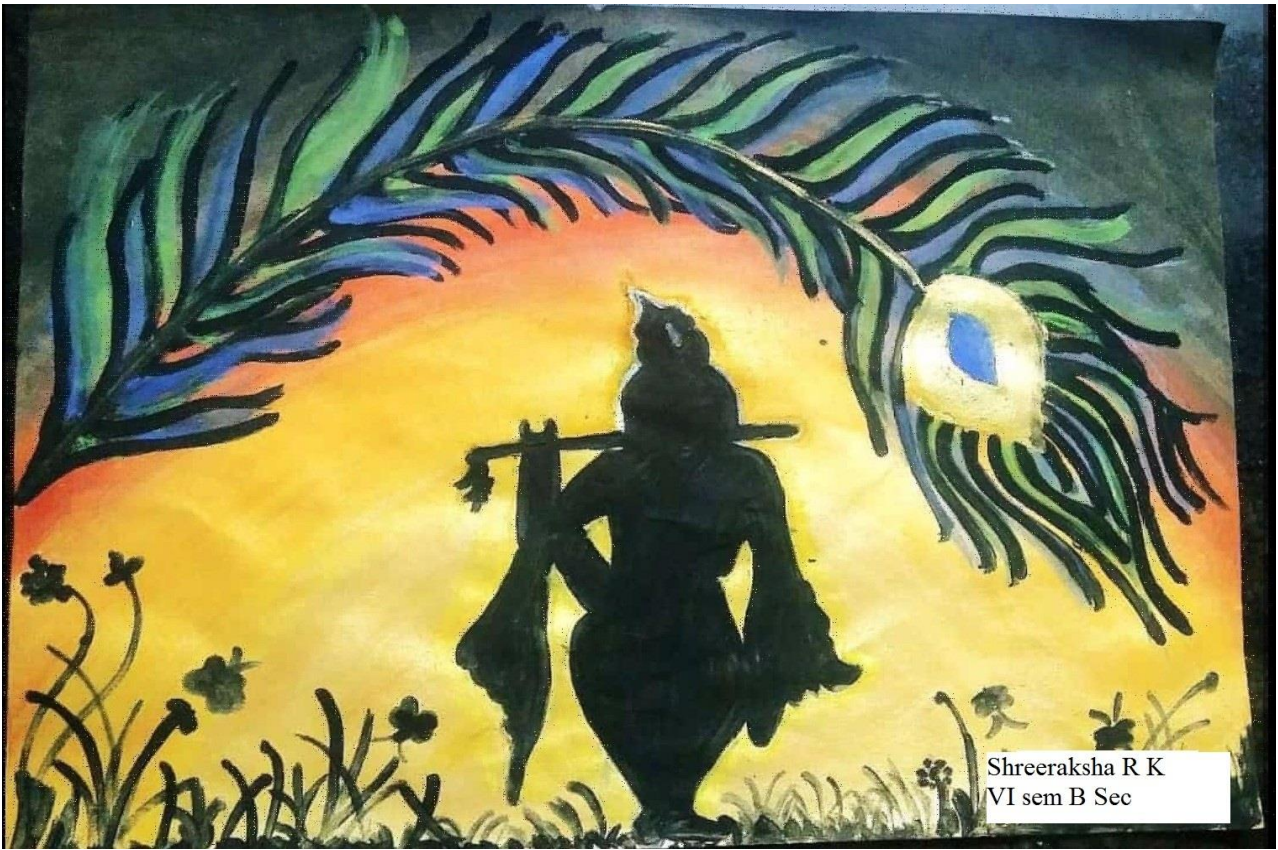
